COUNSELOR-IN-TRAINING



We are offering a new and exciting experience for our area teenagers! The Counselor-in-Training Program is designed to teach leadership, citizenship, and communication skills to teenagers 15-18 years of age. This program is a service learning opportunity that includes the following components: community service and an intensive training on leadership, behavior and conflict management, ages and stages of children, team building, and program planning. CITs will work alongside the 4-H Agent and Cooperative Extension staff to assist, execute and educate our younger summer adventure participants. This program is ultimately about young adults discovering what they are capable of, finding their inner leader, and creating a lasting experience.

- Participants must be 15-18 years of age

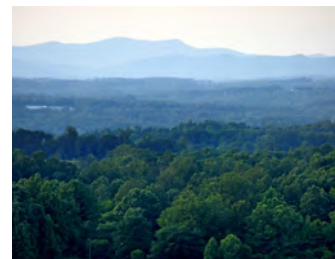
